In exchange for being allowed to add 20 floors to his original plan, he would grant public access to the lobby section of Trump Tower and two public gardens.

I worked quickly, until the other few visitors were gone and a guard came and told me to leave. According to the agreement with the City, the garden should be kept open until 22h. It was about 18h.

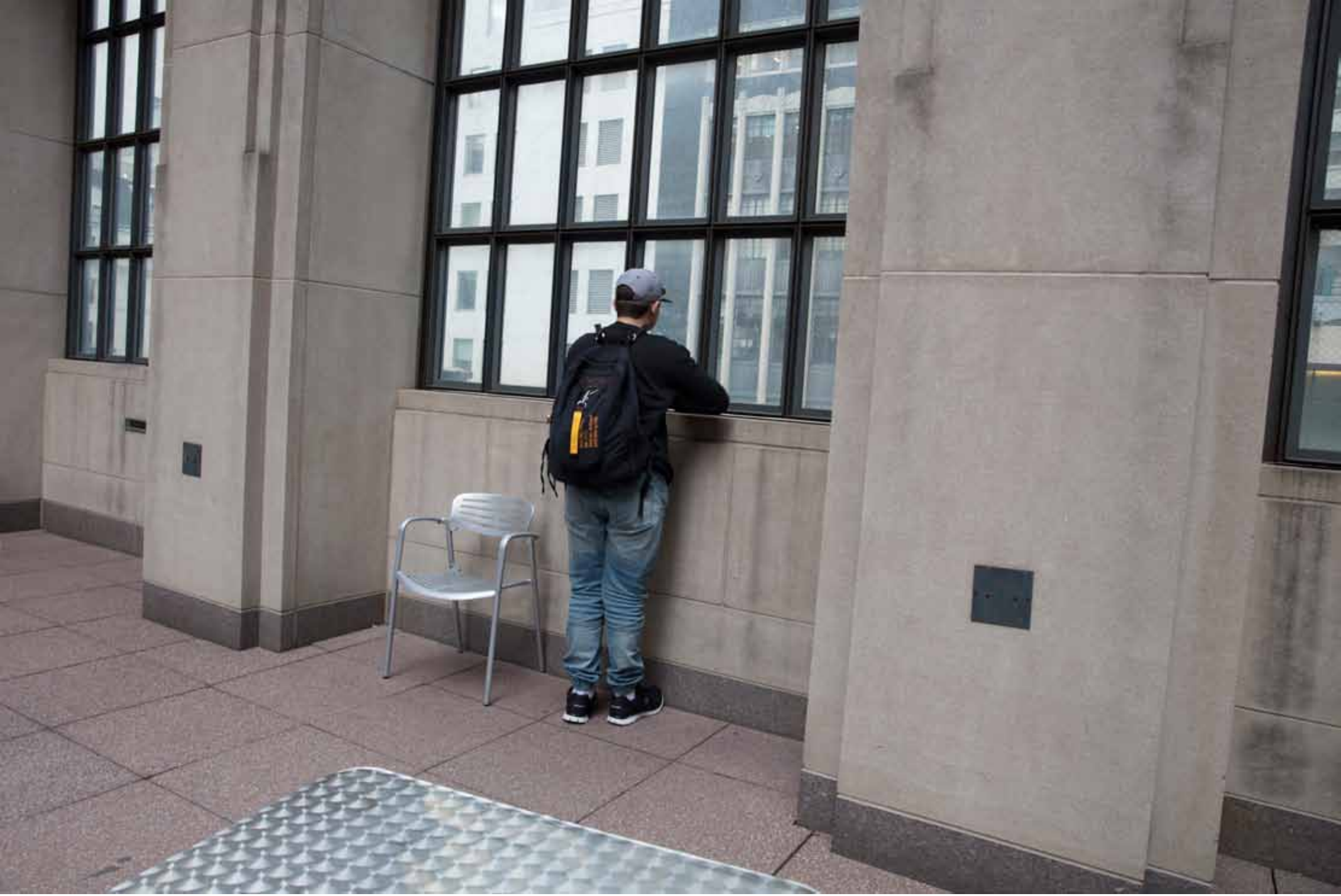
